More supportable, but still weak

Toured on a lower shoulder on the east side of Cedar Mtn from approx 8600-9600 ft. We found a little bit more of a supportable <u>slab</u> than we've been seeing on other recent field days (Taylor Fork, Bacon Rind, Beehive Basin) but still not enough <u>slab</u> cohesion for <u>propagation</u> in Extended Column Tests. Dug five pits between 9000 and 9500 ft on SE, E, and N aspects - got a mixture of ECTX and ECTN results. Snowpack ranged from 1-2.5 ft deep. The snowpack was generally supportable on skis, but stepping out of skis we plunged to the ground. Light snow fell throughout the afternoon with little accumulation.
