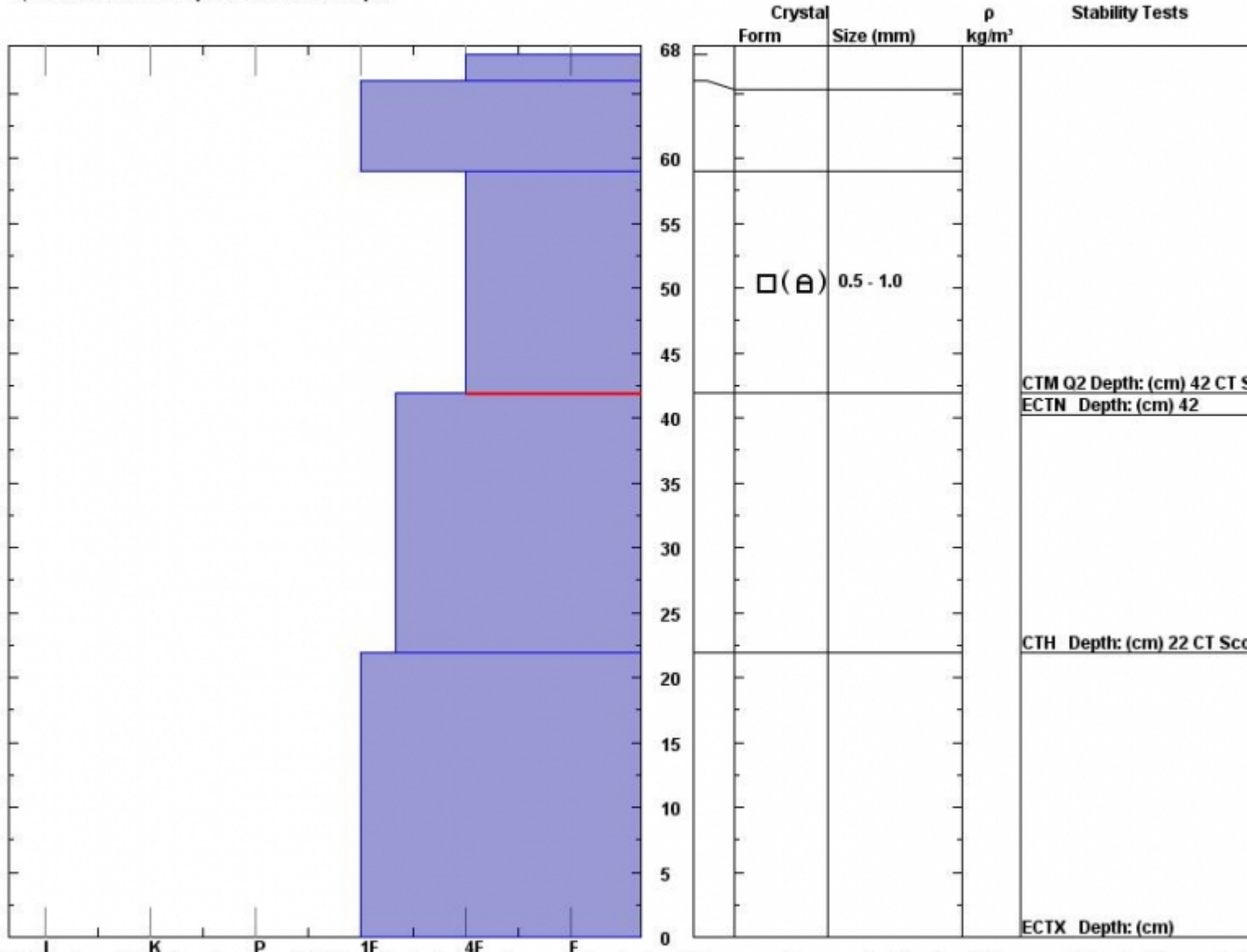

Surprisingly other locations on northerly aspects had started to facet some during sunny days and clear nights. BBSP has noted similar "recycled powder" snow that despite the unseasonably warm temps, there continues to be a temp gradient in the snowpack.
